

ROTARY FOUNDATION FOCUS

Historically the Foundation has directed its support to capital projects; however, limited funding for programmatic requests may be granted. The focus of the Foundation continues to be on those projects that elevate the quality of life for people in the Easton community.

ELIGIBILITY:

Applications may be submitted by 501 (c) (3) non-profit organizations serving people in the Foundation's service area.

PROPOSAL DEADLINE:

Grants will be awarded in June of each year, in amounts commensurate with available funds. Proposals must be submitted by April 1st for consideration in June of the same year.
